Abstract

Cherry angiomas pose a cosmetic problem in some patients. The most commonly recommended **treatment** modalities in the past have been electrodesiccation and **cryotherapy** with liquid nitrogen. This report describes a simple and quick technique for removal of **cherry** angiomas with excellent cosmetic results using a topical anesthetic refrigerant spray and a sharp curet. Patients experience minimal discomfort.

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
